Our goal is to expand access to the design world by providing meaningful youth employment, funding community-led design processes, and hosting community learning opportunities that move the industry toward becoming more representative. Our Design Grants fund community experts to create design solutions for challenges in their neighborhoods.

The Sasaki Foundation Design Grants program seeks ideas that promote equity and empower local communities in Greater Boston and the Gateway Cities. Each year, we issue a call for proposals. Finalists pitch their project ideas to a jury at Pitch Night, a public event. Winners receive funding and nearly a year of access to design experts to advance the project.
